## SOLAR ECLIPSE

A solar eclipse occurs when the Moon passes between the Sun and Earth, blocking or partially blocking the Sun's light.

This can result in a partial or total obscuration of the Sun.

Stillwater is not in the path of totality, but the Sun will be about 93% covered during our maximum eclipse at 1:47pm!

**Note: it is NOT safe to look directly at the sun during a partial solar eclipse unless you have certified eclipse viewing glasses.**
