ABOUT THE SPEAKER Harry Boyte is co-director of the Sabo Center for Democracy and Citizenship at Augsburg College, which he founded at the University of Minnesota’s Hubert H. Humphrey Institute of Public Affairs more than two decades ago. He is also a senior fellow and graduate faculty member at the Humphrey Institute.

Boyte is an architect of the Center for Democracy and Citizenship’s public work approach to civic engagement and democracy, a conceptual framework of citizenship that has gained world-wide recognition for its theoretical innovations and its practical effectiveness in translating lessons from community organizing into institutional and professional change. He is the author of nine books on citizenship, democracy, and community organizing. In the 1960s, he worked for the Rev. Martin Luther King, Jr. as a field secretary with the Southern Christian Leadership Conference in the Civil Rights Movement.
