

The John D. Hoogesteger Memorial Scholarship Fund is awarded annually to persons that are pursuing careers in the field of Fire Protection Engineering. Since its inception in 2001, the scholarship has been awarded to thirty individuals attending programs at the University of Maryland, Oklahoma State University, Worcester Polytechnic Institute, and Eastern Kentucky University.

Approved applicants must be pursuing formal education in the field of fire protection engineering or fire protection engineering technology, as demonstrated by:


- Enrolled in an Institution of Higher Education seeking an undergraduate degree in the field of Fire Safety/Fire Protection Engineering Technology/Fire Protection Engineering.
- Enrolled in an Institution of Higher Education seeking an advanced degree in the field of Fire Protection Engineering or Fire Protection Research.

Approved applicants will be selected from the group of applicants meeting the filing deadline based on the quality of the scholarship application information and the potential return to the field of fire protection engineering.

Submittal of application does not guarantee selection. Scholarship eligibility, determination, award, and notification shall be made within 60 days of the filing deadline.

Scholarships are not automatically renewable from year to year. Previous recipients must re-apply for consideration in following years.

Funds are paid directly to the attended school. Applications shall be post-marked no later than April 30, 2013 to be considered for the Fall/Spring school year. The selection committee may reject applications that do not contain the requested information.


