Oklahoma State University Multimodal Transportation Terminal

The Multimodal Transportation Terminal will be the central location for the OSU Transit System. The bus parking area is large enough to allow for easy access and turning of the buses. The terminal will contain a lobby waiting room, restroom, retail space, and administration offices for OSU Parking and Transit Services. Also included in this project is the Monroe Street Garage, a five-level parking facility.
